

Nitinaht Campground Safety Measures or 2021 Season

To the friends and guests of the Ditidaht Nation

We kindly ask that you keep the following in mind as a way for you to help keep our community safe and secure. As COVID-19 and its variances continue in this global pandemic, Ditidaht Chief and Council have required some additional measures to stay aware of the all who are in their territory. We are stewards of the land, and we are responsible for every person within our territory.

Check In time is from 12noon – 8pm the day of your booking, please plan your travel time accordingly. If you must be outside these times, please email anne@nitinahtstore.ca and we can discuss your options.

(Note: There is **NO ADMITTANCE AFTER 9PM**. The current Public Health Order has restricted visitors to those who reside within Canada and those from the United States of America (USA) who have proof of Vaccinations. Proof of address is strictly enforced.

Additionally, please provide a list of names of each person in your party, regardless of age, in the blank box below so we know who is coming into the owned and operate private property of the Ditidaht Nation and email to:

(Please note, all persons listed are to be already in your family bubble. We do not allow day visitors. If you have a guest coming on a different date than your booking, please provide the date and expected time of arrival and departure in an email or advise the camp host in the campsite.)

The wearing of a mask is not required within the campsite or at the Check In, but will be mandatory in the store area as it is a public indoor space. Please be patient, kind and courteous, we are all in the same storm.

The use of the Nitinaht Store and Café is permitted, please see the store specific protocols and be mindful of the social distancing and the 4 - customer limit inside the store. With your cooperation, we can all enjoy the shared spaces in harmony. We also ask you to access the store via the roadways only to minimize contact with community members. There is roadwork being done blocking the trail accesses through the community field, please use caution and follow signage for your protection.

For the enjoyment of everyone, keep in mind the following: be in your site, be on the beach/water, be on the road, be in the store.

Elevation Kiteboarding will be the Beach Monitors for the entire season, please follow their instructions.
